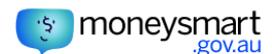

Crisis Assessment and Treatment Teams

Crisis assessment and treatment teams (CATT) are based out of local major hospitals, and provide help during a mental health emergency, including phone support and sending mental health practitioners to attend to individuals in crisis not dissimilar to an ambulance.

To find a local CATT team google the “suburb + CATT” or ring your closest major public hospital.
